Bruce James Duttlinger, 64, Paris Crossing Rt. 1, died at 3:30 p.m. Friday, Oct. 10, at the Lutheran Community Home in Seymour. He had been in failing health for two years.

A retired employee of the Pinkerton Guard Service, Mr. Duttlinger had lived in Jackson County most of his life, having moved recently to the Paris Crossing community in Jennings County.
