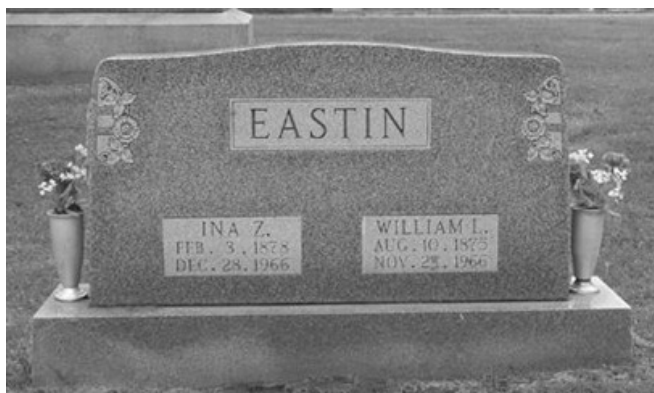

Ex-Ewing Postmaster Succumbs

William L. Eastin, 91, Brownstown, died at 10 p. m. Wednesday at home. He had been in failing health for about six years.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p. m. Saturday at the Zabel Funeral Home, Brownstown, with the Rev. Evan Bolejack, pastor of the Brownstown Christian Church, officiating. Burial in Fairview Cemetery there.

Friends may call at any time at the Zabel Funeral Home. Washington Lodge No. 13, Free and Accepted Masons, at Brownstown, will conduct rites at 8 p. m. tonight at the funeral home.

Mr. Eastin was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church, where he had served as a deacon and treasurer and was an honorary deacon at the time of his death.

He was a merchant in Brownstown for a number of years, served as postmaster of the Ewing post office 15 years and was Brownstown township trustee for two terms. He was a member of Washington Lodge No. 13, Free and Accepted Masons, for over 50 years.

Mr. Eastin was born Aug. 10, 1875, at Kurtz to the late Thomas and Martha Moore Eastin.

He was married July 2, 1899, at the Ratcliff Grove Christian Church to Ina Z. Richardson, who survives.

Survivors, in addition to the widow, include three daughters, Mrs. Ida Fleming, Brownstown, Mrs. William D. McAfee, Hobart, and Mrs. Noland Smith, Medora R1; five grandchildren, and 12 great-grandchildren.
