Marcus V. Eglen, Barber, Expires

Marcus V. Eglen, 55, 333 High-lawn avenue, widely known local barber and musician, died at 6:10 p. m. Sunday at Schneck Memorial Hospital, where he was admitted August 6 for medical treatment. Although he had continued to barber until his last illness, he had been in failing health for the past two years.

Mr. Eglen was an active member of the Church of the Nazarene and had played musical instruments at a number of religious services over a period of many years. He became widely known not only in Seymour and Jackson county, but throughout southern Indiana as well through his musical participation in revivals and other special religious services.

Born July 7, 1903, in Washington County, Mr. Eglen was the son of the late John Thomas and Malinda Reynolds Eglen. He was married Sept. 14, 1923, in Brownstown to Anna Flick, who survives. He moved to Seymour 27 years ago and had resided here since, following the occupation of a barber in a number of local shops and also operating a barber shop of his own at various locations. Many friends regret to learn of his death.

Besides the widow, he is survived by three children: Mrs. Maxine Lewis, of Columbus, O.; Clarence Eglen, of New York, N. Y. and Mrs. Norma Crane, of Seymour. Three sisters: Mrs. Nancy Voyles, of Salem; Mrs. Della Haley, of Louisville, and Mrs. Hattie Hankins, of Seymour, also survive as do six grandchildren. A son, three brothers and seven sisters preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1 p. m. Wednesday from the Church of the Nazarene with the Rev. Roy M. Vaughn, pastor, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
