## Succumbs To Heart Attack

John F. Elstrod, 46, a well known Brownstown resident, died suddenly of a heart attack at his home in Ewing Thursday morning at 8:50 o'clock. On Tuesday he complained of acute indigestion while out on his truck delivering ice, and his death came as a shock to all.

He was born in Indianapolis August 25, 1902, the son of Frederick and Theresa Pferrer Elstrod. He had lived in Brownstown since 1929. He served as a member of the Town Board from 1935 to 1943. For a number of years he has been in charge of the Ebner Ice and Cold Storage substation in Brownstown. He was married in Indianapolis August 25, 1926, to Miss Helen Tuell of Brownstown, who survives. He was a member of Our Lady of Providence Catholic Church in Brownstown.

Surviving besides the mother and widow are two sons, Jack Elstrod, of Brownstown; and Paul Elstrod, at home, and one grandchild.

Funeral services were conducted at the Catholic church Monday morning at 9 o'clock with the Rev. Robert J. Wilhelm, former pastor, in charge. Burial in
