Mrs. Kittie Emerson Dies—One Of B'town's Oldest Natives

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home for ninety-year-old Mrs. Kittie Belle Emerson, one of Brownstown's oldest natives, who died at 6:10 o'clock Saturday evening at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Faye E. Shields.

Mrs. Emerson had been in failing health due to her advanced age for about three years but seriously ill only about a week, following a stroke of paralysis.

The Rev. Wayland E. Siders, pastor of the Brownstown Methodist Church, was in charge of the rites and interment was in Fairview Cemetery.

Mrs. Emerson was born in Brownstown on October 7, 1866, a daughter of the late James A. Clark and Rachel Goslee Clark. She was married on February 24, 1889, to Orlean R. Emerson, who for many years operated the Emerson Drug Store here, which now is owned by his son.

Mr. Emerson died on August 23, 1938.

Surviving in addition to the daughter, Mrs. Shields, at whose home she died, and her son, O. Robert Emerson local druggist, are four grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

Two children are deceased. A son, Floyd C. Emerson, died on May 3, 1937, and a daughter, Miss Helen Emerson, died on July 20, 1912.
