OBITUARY

England—Edward O. England of Medora, age 74, who had been critically ill for a week, died at the county hospital, Seymour, last Wednesday night at 8:30 o'clock of a complication of diseases.

Funeral services were conducted at the Church of the Nazarene, of which he was a member, Friday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock in charge of the pastor, the Rev. C. A. Newby. Burial in Fairview cemetery.

He was born in Jackson county November 27, 1866, to the late Jerry and Nancy Compton England. In 1891, he was married to Laura Newhouse, who died in 1936. Seven children were born to them, two of whom died in infancy. In 1937 he was married to Anna Hamilton who survives. He was a farmer by occupation but retired several years ago because of ill health. He lived in and near Brownstown before moving to Medora.
