Mrs. Lucy England, 86, Dies At Daughter's Home

An illness of five days proved fatal Thursday to eighty-six-year-old Mrs. Lucy Newhouse England, native and life-long resident of Jackson county. Mrs. England died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Charles Silence, southeast of Brownstown, where she had made her home for the past nine years.

Born in this county on December 7, 1866, she was a daughter of the late Henry and Sarah Barkman Newhouse. She was twice married. Her first husband was Oscar Allen Benton and later she was married to Alex England, both of whom are deceased.

Surviving, in addition to the daughter at whose home she died, are two sons, Oscar Benton, of Brownstown, and Ralph England, also of Brownstown.

Funeral rites were held at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon from the Brownstown Church of the Nazarene in charge of the Rev. W. R. Fields, pastor, and burial was in Fairview Cemetery.
