

England — Funeral services, in charge of the Rev. Robt. Crosby, were conducted at the Presbyterian church this afternoon at 2 o'clock for Mrs. Ollie England, age 80, who died at her home in Seymour Monday morning at 5 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery. She had been in ill health for some time.

Mrs. England was a native of Jackson county. She was born to the late George W. and Eliza Julian Skinner near Pleasant Grove July 16, 1860. On October 5, 1893, she was married to Henry England, who died in 1928. To their union were born two children, a daughter and a son, the son dying in infancy.
