Ralph England Dies— Rites To Be Tuesday

Ralph England, 53, Brownstown R2, died at 11:45 p. m. Saturday at his home after an illness of four years and being seriously ill for one week.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p. m. Tuesday from the Johnson Funeral Home, Vallonia, with the Rev. Orrin Thayer, former pastor of the Vallonia Methodist Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
