Rites Held For Medora Man

Funeral services for Estill Framer, 72, of Medora R1 were conducted this afternoon from the Johnson Funeral Home at Vallonia with the Rev. Albert Temple, pastor of the Church of the Nazarene at Haleysburg, officiating. Burial in Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.

Mr. Farmer, a resident of the county since 1944, died at 3:30 p. m. Friday at his home. He had been ill for about six months.

A retired employe of Fibercast Division of General Motors, he was a member of the Baptist Church.

Born May 24, 1894, in Harlan, Ky., he was the son of the late Leonard and Lourenia Farmer. On Jan. 17, 1920, at Harlan, he married the former Arta Fee, who survives.
