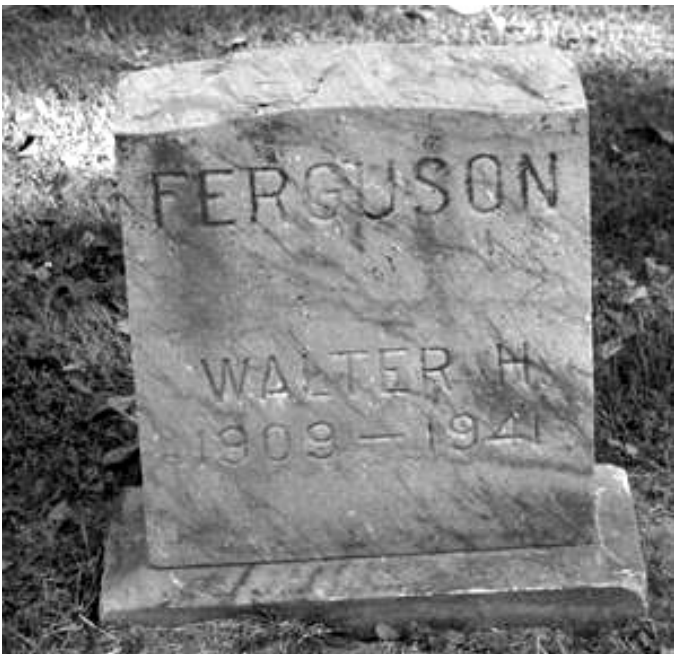

Former Co. Man Killed-- 11 Injured

When Two Cars Crash On Road
67 Near Glens Valley Sunday
Afternoon.

Walter H. Ferguson, aged 31, of Indianapolis, died at the City Hospital, Indianapolis, Sunday night at 9:05 o'clock, after receiving fatal injuries in an auto accident Sunday afternoon in which eleven others were injured. Mr. Ferguson formerly lived in Jackson county near Brownstown.

According to police who investigated the wreck near Glens Valley, the driver of the car in which Ferguson was riding, lost his hat and made a grab for it when his car swerved off the road.

The driver of an approaching car seeing the other car out of control tried to avoid a crash and they crashed into each other.

The car in which Ferguson was riding was a coupe, with two of his children riding on the ledge in back of the rear seat, and two other passengers were riding in the car beneath the trunk lid.

Funeral services were conducted at the home of his brother, William, in Seymour this afternoon at 1:30 o'clock and at the Pleasant Grove church at 2:30, the Rev. Elmo Smith officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery, Brownstown.

Mr. Ferguson was the son of Alex and Ardie Cockerham Ferguson and was born in Brownstown township August 20, 1909. He was married to Ermine Day of Crothersville. They lived in Brownstown township and later moved to Indianapolis, where he was employed in a foundry.

Surviving besides the widow and parents are three children, William, Norma Jean and Wilma Lou. Also surviving are four brothers and four sisters: Henry and William Ferguson, Mrs. Evelyn Elmore and Mrs. Bernice Amos, all of Seymour, Charles, of Mitchell; Mrs. Prudence Allman and Otis Ferguson, both of Brownstown township, and Mrs. Mayme Johnson of Indianapolis.
