

## DEATH RECORD

HETTIE J. FINDLEY, familiarly known as "Aunt Hettie" died Saturday morning, February 13, 1904, of bowed trouble, aged 68 years and 15 days

She was a daughter of Hugh A. and Rebecca C, Findley, both decrased, and was of a family of thirteen children, six boys and seven girls, all of whom have preceded her to the grave except James H., of this place, and George, of Cortland, She was been January 29, 1836, on the home farm, about two miles east of town, where she died and where she made her house for many years with her brother, Wm. Findley, and after his death with his widow, Mrs. Sarab Findley, and family. The funeral services largely attended, were held at the M. E. church in Brownstown, Monday afternoon, Febrnary 15th, at 2 o'clock, Rev. T. W. Northcott officiating after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery. Deceased was well known and had many friends. She was of & quiet, kind and pleasing disposition, and as the pastor said, "Her religious life was exemplary, not emotional, bub of even tenor. Her faith in God was abiding, and she only waited the time of her release,"
