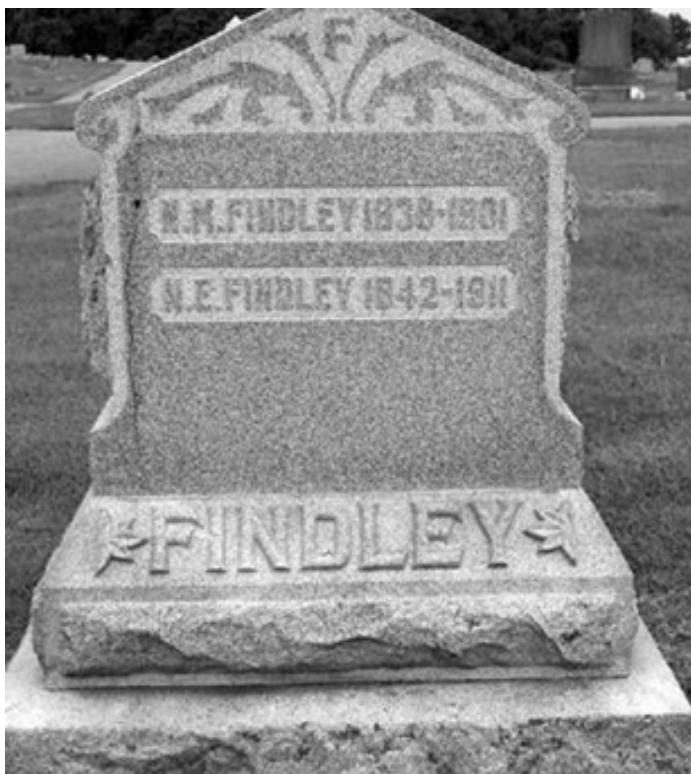

DEATH RECORD.

NICHOLAS M. FINDLEY, a well known and highly respected citizen of this county, died at his home about a mile east of Cortland, Monday, August 5, 1901, of typhoid fever after an illness of only about nine days aged 62 years, 9 months and 19 days.

The remains were brought here this morning and the funeral services were held at the M. E. church at 10 o'clock, Rev. C. C. Bonnell officiating, after which interment took place in Fairview cemetery.

Deceased was a son of Hugh A. and Rebecca Findley and was born October 16, 1838. He was united in marriage to Nancy E. Lawell, January 18, 1863, who survives him. To their union were born three children, viz: Walter, Bruce and Hugh, all of whom are living, but the former is out west and was not present at the funeral.

Deceased was a prominent and substantial farmer and stock-raiser of Hamilton township and was well and favorably known over the county. He was an industrious man and a kind and indulgent husband and father.

He was a brother of Jas. H. Findley of this place and "Aunt Hettie" Findley, who resides east of town.

The widow has the heartfelt sympathy of many friends in her sad affliction, having lost her father, mother, husband, sister and sister-in-law by death within the past sixteen months.
