Jacob O. Fisher, 90, of Brownstown died at 8:30 a.m. Monday, Oct. 1, at the Hoosier Christian Village at Brownstown after a six-month illness.

The World War I veteran was a retired motel manager at Key West, Fla.

Funeral will begin at 1 p.m. today, Wednesday, Oct. 3, from the Winklepleck-Weesner Funeral Home at Brownstown with the Rev. Marshall Weaver officiating. Burial will be at Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.
