## Mrs. Madeline Fitch, 36, Dies—Rites Set

Mrs. Madeline Fitch, 36, Seymour R1, died at 1:30 p. m. Wednesday in Schneck Memorial Hospital after being ill for three years. She was admitted to the local hospital March 15 for medical treatment.

Mrs. Fitch, a member of the Pilgrim Holiness Church here, was a life-long resident of Jackson County.

She was born June 18, 1923, in Seymour, daughter of William M. and May Jarvis Amos, who survive. On May 23, 1941, in Seymour, she married John Fitch, who also survives.

Other survivors, besides the parents and husband, include six children, Danny Fitch, of Seymour, and Richard Lee, John Timothy, William, Lynette Jane and Paula Kay Fitch, all at home; four brothers; B.
