Mrs. Fleetwood, Of B'town, Dies, Rites Monday

Mrs. Strawsy Lee Fleetwood, 90, 814 West Cross street, Brownstown, died at 5 p. m. Friday in the Jackson Park Convalescent Center after an illness of 10 weeks.

She was born January 17, 1885, in the Ratcliff Grove community to the late Smith T. and Lydia Ann Acton Stilwell. She had lived in Jackson County all her life and had lived in Brownstown since 1913. On January 17, 1903, in Brownstown she married Otto Fleetwood, who preceded her in death on May 15, 1965.

She had been a member of the Brownstown Christian Church longer than any other member and was a charter member of the Home Demonstration Club, member of the Pythian Sisters, a member of the Senior Citizens Club, and of the WW Club.

Survivors include one son, Gilbert Fleetwood, of Brownstown; four daughters, Mrs. Myron (Irene) Brown, of Brownstown, Mrs. Lewis (Gladys) Chapman and Mrs. John Robert (Elizabeth Ann) Reed, both of West Palm Beach, Fla., and Mrs. Ralph L.
