## Heart Attack Fatal To Mrs. Bessie Flick— Brownstown Native

Mrs. Bessie L. Flick, 40, of Seymour, who suffered a heart attack shortly after 6:00 o'clock Monday evening at her home, died in the Jackson county hospital, minutes after being rushed there for treatment.

Born in Brownstown, February 16, 1920, Mrs. Flick was a daughter of the late Dan and Leota Briner Cockerham. She was married here on March 9, 1938, to Arthur A. Flick, who survives.

Also surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Charles Huffman, Seymour, and Nancy and Connie Lou Flick, both at home; three brothers, Thomas P. Cockerham, Medora; J. C. Cockerham, Dupont, and William Cockerham, and four sisters Mrs. Frank Owens, Mrs. Merrill Stewart and Mrs. George Engleking, Seymour, and Mrs. Maurice Grider, Flat Rock.

She was a member of the First Baptist Church, Seymour, the Reddington Home Demonstration Club and the VFW Auxiliary in Seymour.
