Richard "Dick" Fordice Dies In Office Of B'town Physician

Funeral rites were held Sunday afternoon from the Johnson Funeral Home in Vallonia, for Richard Darhires "Dick" Fordice, of Brownstown.

Mr. Fordice died about 11:30 o'clock Thursday morning in the office of a Brownstown physician where he had gone for medical treatment.

Born July 1, 1883, in Washington county, he was a son of the late John and Harriett Huckelberry Fordice. On July 9, 1907, he was married in Brownstown to Bertha Ann Hines, who survives.

By occupation he was a farmer and was a member of the Brownstown Methodist Church.

Mr. Fordice was the father of nine children, six sons and three daughters. Five sons survive, as do the three daughters. They are Edward Fordice, at home, William Sherman Fordice, Butlerville, Elmer Roy "Jim" Fordice, of Brownstown, Scott Francis Fordice and Lloyd Joe Fordice, both at home, and Mrs. John Sondergelt, of Brownstown, Mrs. Idalee Silence and Mrs. Ethel Mae England, both of Brownstown township.

A son, Ralph, is deceased. He also leaves two sisters, Mrs. Ida May McCleary, of Brownstown, and Mrs. Alice Wilkerson, of New Athens, Illinois, 13 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

The Rev. Orrin D. Thayer, now pastor of a Methodist Church in the Evansville district and former pastor of the Vallonia Methodist Church, was in charge of the rites. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery here.
