Mrs. Lucy B. Forgey Expires at Freetown

Mrs. Lucy B. Forgey, 56, died early this morning in her home at Freetown.

Mrs. Forgey, who had been ill for three years, died of complications. She was a life-time resident of Jackson county and before her illness was an active member of the Freetown Evangelical United Brethren Church.

Mrs. Forgey was born March 22, 1894, at Freetown, a daughter of Samuel and Louisa Moore Brock. Her father preceded her in death. On April 23, 1916, she married C. C. Forgey in Jeffersonville.
