Alvin Fosbrink services Thursday

Alvin L. Fosbrink, 68, of Brownstown, died at 3:57 a.m. today at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital.

A member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Brownstown, he was a retired Cummins Engine Co. employee and a U.S. Army veteran of World War II.

Born Nov. 21, 1924, in Brownstown, he was a son of Carl and Florence Garris Fosbrink. He married Ruby Fee on March 16, 1946, in Brownstown, and she survives.
