Carl Lee Fosbrink, 68, of Seymour died at 8:17 a.m. Saturday, Dec. 12, 2015, at his home.

Born Jan. 5, 1947, in Seymour, he was the son of Alvin Fosbrink, who preceded him in death, and Ruby Fee Fosbrink, who survives in Brownstown.
