Clarence H. Frier, Husband Former Local Resident, Dies

Clarence H. Frier, of Hot Springs, Arkansas, husband of the former Audra Doerr, of Brownstown, died Friday in Hot Springs at the age of 80 years.

He was born May 16, 1891, in Chattanooga, Tennessee, a son of the late George and Eleanora Henson Frier, and, for 33 years, was an electrical engineer with the Oklahoma Gas & Electric Company.

Funeral rites were held Monday morning from the Zabel Funeral Home in charge of the Rev. Ernest Anderson, pastor of the Brownstown Baptist Church. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery.
