Gerl Evans Furr, 83, of Brownstown died at 8:50 a.m. Tuesday at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital following a lengthy illness.

He moved to Jackson County in 1950 and was a member of United Methodist Church, Brownstown; Masonic Temple; Washington Lodge 13, F&AM, Brownstown; Elks Lodge 462, Seymour; and Indiana State and Jackson County Retired Teachers associations.

A graduate of Indiana State University, he taught high school for 43 years at Brownstown, Cloverdale, Marengo, Kennard and Morristown.

He coached basketball, track and softball and served as a referee for 10 years. He sponsored HiY for 17 years.

Born Oct. 22, 1908, in Cloverdale, he was a son of Cornelius McCarty and Nancy Evans Furr. He married Edna Haney on Nov. 5, 1932, in Terre Haute, and she survives.
