Henry P. Heller, an aged resident of Brownstown township, died at his home one mile east of Brownstown Wednesday following an illness of pneumonia fever which lasted five days. The deceased was 81 years old.

Mr. Heller had been a life-long resident of Jackson county having been born at Brownstown February 14, 1831. He resided on the farm where his death occurred for seven-and-a-half years. The deceased was twice united in marriage. His first marriage was to Henrietta C. Chapman, June 14, 1870 who preceded him to the grave April 17, 1910. His second marriage was to Mrs. Rachel McNiece, September 16, 1915, who survives him. The deceased is also survived by four children, Ralph and Emil Heller, who reside near Brownstown, Mrs. Mary N. Gloyd, of Siles, Ill., and Mrs. Cora H. Hamilton, of Kenosha, Wis., several other relatives and many friends.

The funeral service will be held from the Brownstown Methodist church Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. R. I. Black, conducting the obseques. Interment will be in Fairview cemetery at Brownstown.
