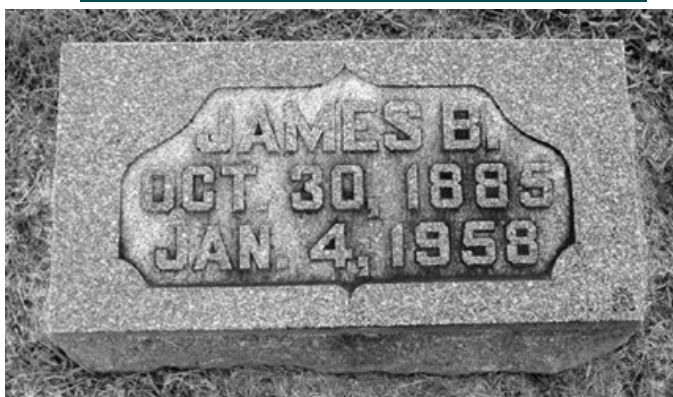

Rites Held For James B. Heller

Funeral services for James B. Heller, 72, Brownstown, were conducted this afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home at Brownstown with the Rev. H. G. Ramsey, pastor of the Brownstown Methodist Church, in charge. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.

Mr. Heller, admitted Saturday morning to Schneck Memorial Hospital for medical treatment, died at 1 p. m. Saturday at the hospital. He had been in declining health since last April.

Mr. Heller, who had lived his entire life in and around Brownstown, was born Oct. 30, 1885, in Brownstown township, the son of the late John W. and Phebe Doerr Heller. He was never married.

A retired postal clerk, Mr. Heller served 30 years as postal clerk on Baltimore and Ohio Railroad on a run between Cincinnati and St. Louis.

Mr. Heller was a member of the Brownstown Methodist Church and a 50-year member of Brownstown Lodge No. 60, Knights of Pythias.

Well known and highly respected, Mr. Heller's death has saddened the hearts of the many people who knew him in Brownstown and throughout Jackson county.
