DEATH SUMMONS MRS. RACHEL E. HELLER

Life-Resident of County Succumbs Saturday Following Illness of Six Months.

Rachel E. Heller, age seventy-seven, Freetown, died at the home of her son, Price McNiece, at 11 o'clock Saturday morning following an illness of about six months.

Funeral services were conducted at 1 o'clock this afternoon at Pleasant Grove, with burial in Brownstown.

Mrs. Heller was born near Pleasant Grove November 22, 1853, the daughter of Jessie and Carline Browning, both of whom are now deceased, and lived in Jackson county all of her life. She had made her home for some time with her son, Charles Hayes, at Brownstown. She was a member of the Freetown Christian Church.

Surviving her, in addition to Mr. McNiece and Mr. Hayes, are six grandchildren and a sister, Mrs. Elvira Kerner, who lives south of Freetown.
