Rites Conducted For Mrs. Sonora Heller, 88

Funeral services for Mrs. Sonora Heller, 88, a resident of Brownstown practically all her life and a prominent woman there, were conducted this afternoon from the home of her daughter, Mrs. Elizabeth Robbins, in Brownstown with the Rev. C. W. Taylor, Brownstown Methodist pastor, in charge. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mrs. Heller died at 9 o'clock Saturday night at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Robbins, in Brownstown. She had been in failing health for the past two years.

Mrs. Heller was born March 17, 1865, in Washington township, the daughter of the late David and Martha Jane Keach Young. She was married January 17, 1883, in Brownstown to Peter Heller, who died March 29, 1939. She had been a member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church for 68 years and had been very active in its work. She also was a member of the Pythian Sisters Lodge in Brownstown and had been active in its affairs until about two years ago when her activity was limited because of ill health.
