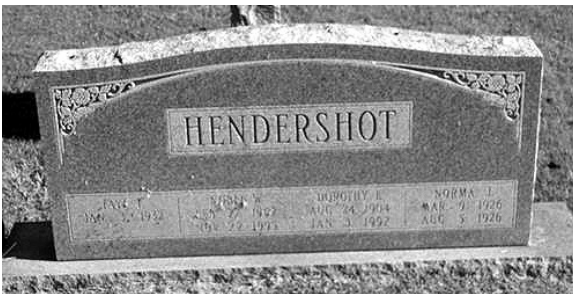

## Noble W. Hendershot Sr.

Feb. 22, 1902-Nov. 22, 1995

Noble W. Hendershot Sr., 93, of Seymour died at 8:10 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 22, 1995, at Memorial Hospital in Seymour after being in failing health for two years.

Mr. Hendershot was a retired carpenter and building contractor. The U.S. Army veteran was a member of the American Legion Post 89 and Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie 655, both of Seymour.

Born Feb. 22, 1902, in Jackson County, he was a son of Alfred and Grace Rachel Metlick Hendershot. He was a lifelong resident of Jackson County. On March 31, 1924, in Clearspring, he married Dorothy L. Ryan and she died on Jan. 3, 1992.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Joseph (Alta) Moser and Faye Hendershot, both of Seymour; two grand-
