S. Henderson, Former County Officer, Dies

Simeon L. Henderson, age eighty-eight, a former recorder of Jackson county and former trustee of Grassy Fork township, died early today at the home of Mr. and Mrs. W. A. Hornback, 315 West Bruce street. He had been ill for the past three days.

Mr. Henderson, who was widely known in Jackson county as a native of this county, where he was born on October 3, 1856. He was the son of the late William and Margaret A. Cook Henderson. He was married on August 5, 1919, in Louisville, to Rose B. Weddle, who died in September, 1928.

Mr. Henderson, who was a retired school teacher, had served two terms as recorder of Jackson county and also had served two terms as trustee of Grassy Fork township. He was a member of the Russell Chapel Church and of Washington Lodge No. 13, Free and Accepted Masons, at Brownstown. A host of friends from throughout the county mourn his passing.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon from the Voss Mortuary with Dr. A. A. Cohn, pastor of the First Baptist Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.
