John Henson, 86, of Brownstown Rt. 1 died at 3:35 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 22, at the Hoosier Christian Village at Brownstown. He had been ill two months.

Funeral was Tuesday, Dec. 27, at the Johnson Funeral Home at Vallonia with the Rev. Cam Huffman officiating and burial was at Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.

The lifelong Jackson County resident was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church. He had been an electrician for the former Brownstown Power and Light Co., a farmer and an employee of Kieffer Paper Mills of Brownstown, the Brownstown Central School Corp. and Bundy Brothers of Medora.

Henson also was a former member of the Red Mens and Odd Fellows lodges.

Born Jan. 12, 1897, in Bartholomew County, he was a son of the late John W. and Fannie Shipley Henson. He married the former Addie Blankenship at Jeffersonville on July 8, 1918, and she survives.

Also surviving are nine children, Carroll "Bud" Henson of Brownstown, May Henson and Loryne Hobbs, both of Brownstown Rt. 1, Kathryn Roy of Seymour, Mary E. Lawles of Columbus, Kay Staniford of Salem, Alyce Culp of Madison, John Henson Jr. of Rockford, Mich., and Eugene Henson of Disputana, Va.
