## Former Local Man Expires

**Adolph Herrman, 68, Dies Monday At Indianapolis--Burial Here Thursday.**

Adolph E. Herrmann, aged 68 years, a former and well-known Brownstown resident, died at his home in Indianapolis Monday. Several years ago he suffered a stroke of paralysis after which he had never fully recovered.

Funeral services will be held at the Moore & Kirk Mortuary in Indianapolis Thursday morning at 10 o'clock. The body will be brought to Brownstown and taken direct to Fairview cemetery, where short services will be held about 12 or 12:30 o'clock.

Mr. Herrmann was a native of Germany and was the youngest son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Henry Herrmann and came to Brownstown with his parents when a small child. He was married in Brownstown to Miss Nora Vanover, who survives. The family moved to Indianapolis a number of years ago.

Survivors besides the widow are one son, Henry Herrmann, of Gary; two daughters, Mrs. Jeanette Snyder, of Franklin; Mrs. Edna McCormick of Indianapolis; a granddaughter, and one brother, Ed Herrmann, of Colorado.
