Mrs. Hess, 102, Dies, Rites Set

Mrs. Allie Hess, 102, formerly of Brownstown R1, died at 9:15 a. m. Tuesday at the Jackson Park Convalescent Center.

She was a member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church.

Mrs. Hess was born Nov. 16, 1875, in Brownstown township, the daughter of the late George and Louisa Meyers Fosbrink. She was the granddaughter of John Hermon and Catherine Westendorf Fosbrink who came to the United States in 1838 and were among the pioneer settlers in Jackson County, establishing a farm in the Wegan area.

She married Lewis Hess, who preceded her in death in the late 1930s. Most of her life was spent in Jackson and Washington counties.

A son, Clarence, also preceded her in death.

A nephew, John Hess, of Morocco, survives.

Services will be conducted at 2 p. m. Thursday from the Brownstown Presbyterian Church with the Rev. Robert Reid, pastor, officiating. Burial in Fairview Cemetery.
