

Funeral Services Held For Earl Hicks, 34

Funeral services for Earl Hicks, 34, of 313½ East Walnut street, Indianapolis, were conducted this morning from the Brownstown Christian Church, with Chaplain Minton, of the Veterans Administration Hospital, Indianapolis, in charge. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown. Military rites were conducted by the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the American Legion.

Mr. Hicks succumbed Friday at the Veterans Administration Hospital, Indianapolis, after an illness of two weeks duration. A barber by occupation, he was married on August 9, 1947, at North Vernon, to Frances Kinder, of Brownstown, who survives.

Although Mr. Hitks had never resided in Brownstown, he had visited there frequently and had many friends there who join with relatives and other friends in Indianapolis in mourning his death.

Mr. Hicks was a native of Greenville, Ind., where he was born September 1, 1915, the son of William Edgar and Rosey Annabelle Ruyle. The mother preceded him in death, but the father survives.
