David Jess Hill rites Thursday

David Jess Hill, 87, of Brownstown died at 9:45 a.m. Monday, May 30, 1994, at Scott County Hospital, Scottsburg. He had been ill for several months.

Mr. Hill was a disabled U.S. Air Force veteran of World War II.

He was a member of Brownstown Christian Church, Free and Accepted Masons 13, Order of Pastern Star 264 and American Legion 112, all of Brownstown; Scottish Rite, Shrine Temple Legion of Honor and White Shrine, all of Indianapolis; York Rite, Seymour; Odd Fellows Lodge and Rebecca Lodge, both of Paoli; and the Disabled American Veterans.

Born April 26, 1907, in Hazard, Ky., he was a son of Pete
