Medora Man Dies Monday Services Set

Wilson Holeman, 70, Medora, died at 1 p. m. Monday at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Marion. A native of Jackson County, he had been ill for several months.

A retired carpenter, Mr. Holeman was born May 9, 1905, in Jackson County to the late Oscar and Alma Wilson Holeman. On August 23, 1925, he married Edith Nowling. They were later divorced.
