

## May 2, 1910-Nov. 19, 1996

Francis Horn, 86, of Seymour died at 12:10 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 19, 1996, at his home.

Mr. Horn formerly was employed at Seymour Woolen Mill and retired from the city of Seymour as a truck driver. He was a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church in Seymour and was a U.S. Navy veteran of World War II, serving on the USS Patterson.

Born May 2, 1910, in Jackson County, he was a son of Andrew and Elizabeth Parr Horn. On Nov. 19, 1949, in Columbus, he married Irene Cornett Lane, and she survives.

Other survivors include a sister-in-law, Jewell Nowling, Columbus.
