Charles W. Hubbard, Aged Local Man, Dies

Charles W. Hubbard, 84, died early this morning at his home in Brownstown.

Funeral rites will be at 2:30 o'clock Friday afternoon from the Spurgeon Funeral Home, in charge of Elder Dewey Allman, of Seymour. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery, in Brownstown.

Born in Greene county, June 16, 1880, Mr. Hubbard was a son of the late Henry and Ellen Cox Hubbard.

He was twice married. His first wife, whom he married September 26, 1905, was Iva Baughman, deceased; and on May 19, 1941, he was married to Cora Niewedde who survives.

Mr. Hubbard was a retired farmer and laborer.
