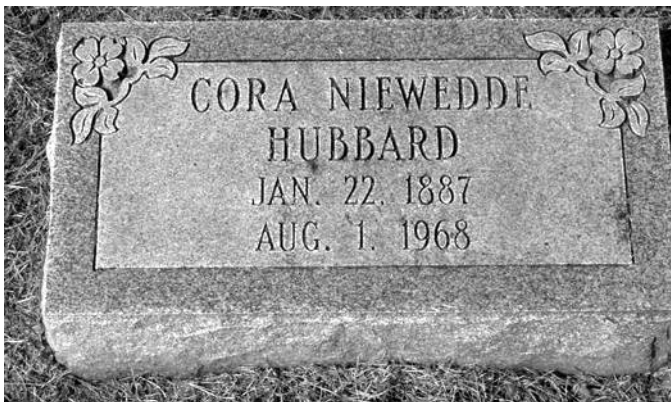

Mrs. Cora Hubbard Dies Suddenly— Rites Held Saturday

Funeral rites were held Saturday afternoon from the Spurgeon Funeral Home, followed by burial in Fairview Cemetery, here, for 81-year-old Mrs. Cora Niewedde Hubbard.

Mrs. Hubbard died suddenly Thursday morning at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Dorothy Boling, 402 Ewing street in Seymour.

A native of Sparksville, she was born January 22, 1887, a daughter of the late Charles and Rosena Morgan Knight.

She was married three times. Her first marriage was to Bige Hall, in 1900. Following his death she was married to Fred Niewedde in 1913, who died in 1936 and, in 1941, she married Charles Hubbard, who died in July of 1964.

Surviving are three sons, Roy Hall, Riggins, Idaho; Albert Niewedde, Crothersville and Clarence Niewedde, Medora; three daughters, Mrs. Virginia Cordell, Mrs. Dorothy Boling, and Mrs. Charles (Nora) Lucas, all of Seymour; a sister, Mrs. Flora Zelenke, of Troy, New York, four stepsons, four step-daughters, 33 grandchildren and 45 great-grandchildren.

A son, two daughters, two brothers and a sister are deceased.

Mrs. Hubbard is a former resident of Brownstown and a member of the Rock-of-Light Tabernacle here.

The Rev. Alex McIntosh, pastor of the Seymour Church of God, officiated at the funeral rites.
