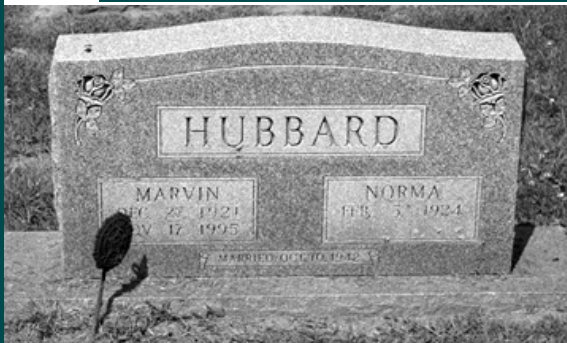

## Marvin Hubbard

Dec. 27, 1921-Nov. 17, 1995

Marvin Hubbard, 73, of 1952. He married Norma Seymour died at 6:50 p.m. Spurgeon in Austin on Oct. Friday, Nov. 17, 1995, at his home. He had been in failing health since Nov. 11, 1994.

Mr. Hubbard was a retired payroll supervisor for Cosco Inc., Columbus. He was a member of Seymour Christian Church and was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II. He was past Exalted Ruler of Elks Lodge 462; a life member of American Legion Post 89; a life member of Veterans Foreign War 1925; and an associate member of Fraternal Order of Police Don Winn Lodge 108.

Born Dec. 27, 1921, in Austin, he was a son of Clarence and Edna Scott Hubbard. He moved to Jackson County in

1952. He married Norma Seymour in Austin on Oct. 10, 1942, and she survives.

Other survivors include three brothers, Joe Hubbard, Brownstown; Gilbert Hubbard, Austin; and George Hubbard, Boonville. A brother and two sisters preceded him in death.
