Leon M. Humphrey, 73, Vallonia, died at 10:06 p.m. Sunday May 10, 1998 at Heritage House, Seymour.

Mr. Humphrey was retired from Cummins Engine Company and was a World War II veteran. He was a member of Vallonia Christian Church and an elder of Vallonia Christian Church where he held various offices.
