Ora K. Hunsucker Dies At Hospital

Ora K. Hunsucker, 65, who for several years had owned a grocery store and filling station at Acme, died late Tuesday afternoon at the Jackson county hospital where he had been a patient for a week.

Mr. Hunsucker had been in failing health for several years.

A native of Kansas, he was born September 28, 1890, a son of the late John E. and Eliza Fleetwood Hunsucker. Most of his adult life had been spent in Lawrence and Jackson county and prior to purchasing the Acme store he was a farmer.

He was married in Brownstown on February 2, 1916, to Jennie Browning, who survives, as do a son, Charles E. Hunsucker, R1, Brownstown; three brothers, Ellis Hunsucker, Edinburg; Claude Hunsucker, Washington, and Maurice Hunsucker, R1, Bedford, and a sister, Mrs. Bert Wilson, Sullivan. Three grandchildren also survive.

Funeral rites will be held at 10:30 o'clock Friday morning from the Winklepleck Funeral Home in Brownstown, in charge of the Rev. Earl Carmichael, pastor of the Freetown Evangelical United Brethren Church. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery here.
