Mrs. Louisa Hurley Dies at Brownstown

Mrs. Louisa C. Hurley, 88, Brownstown, who lived in Brownstown for many years and was prominent in church work there, died early this morning at her home in Brownstown. Death was due to general infirmities.

Mrs. Hurley was born November 17, 1861, in Tompkinsville, Ky., the daughter of the late William and Luevesta Bartley Emert. She was married November 21, 1890, at Bolles, Tenn., to George W. Hurley, who died January 29, 1920.

She was an active member of the Brownstown Christian Church and enjoyed a wide acquaintance of friends who mourn her death.

She is survived by one son, Claude Hurley, of Brownstown; three daughters, Mrs. Lavesta McCrary, Mrs. Essie Sommers, both of Brownstown and Mrs. Bessie Finchum, of Brownville, Ind.; a sister, Mrs. Nora J. Crawford, of Tompkinsville, Ky.; 13 grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
