Heart Attack Fatal To Cledous W. Hurt, Well-Known Grocer

A heart attack, suffered late Monday afternoon, proved fatal to Cledous W. Hurt, 56, of Cortland, who had operated grocery stores in several county communities.

Mr. Hurt died at the Jackson county hospital about 6:30 o'clock, less than two hours after he had been admitted for medical treatment.

Funeral rites will be held at 1:15 o'clock Thursday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home, in Brownstown, and at 2:00 o'clock in Cortland Christian Church. William Weaver, of Warren, former pastor, will be in charge. Interment will be in Brownstown Fairview Cemetery.

A native of Everton, Missouri, Mr. Hurt was born October 26, 1906, a son of the late James Allen and Nancy Belle England Hurt. He had lived in Jackson county since 1936.

For six years he owned and operated a grocery store at Free-town, for thirteen years was a grocer in Cortland and presently owned a cottage grocery on Seventh street in Seymour.

Mr. Hurt was married, October 24, 1931, in Chicago, to Frances Korb, who survives.

Also surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Neal E. Partain, of Greenwood; a son, Cleodous James Hurt, at home; a granddaughter, Diana Lynn Partain, of Greenwood; two brothers, Lawrence Hurt, Portland, Oregon, and Frank D. Hurt, Cortland, and a sister, Mrs. Gilbert Rohr, Cortland, R.I.

He was a member of the Cortland Christian Church.
