59-Year-Old Medora Man Is Found Dead

Paul Ingram, 59, of Medora, was found dead at his home Friday by a Standard Oil Company truck driver.

According to Victor H. Burkholder, deputy county coroner, death was due to pulmonary embolism and it is believed Mr. Ingram had been dead about 24 hours.

Private funeral rites were Saturday afternoon from the Hague Funeral home in Medora in charge of the Rev. Fred Shepard, of the Pentecostal Church. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery in Brownstown.

Born in Washington County, July 1, 1912, he was a son of the late Hardin and Carrie Mikkels Ingram.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. May Bowers, of Medora, and Mrs. Brenda Brock, of Uniontown; three grandchildren and two sisters, Mrs. Irene Davidson of Medora, and Mrs. Ruby Thompson, of Campbellsburg.
