

lames B. Irwin, 72, Dies — Rites at B'town

James B. Irwin, 72, a former resident of this vicinity, died Tuesday at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Janet Stivers, in Santa Fe, New Mexico, following a heart attack.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p. m. Saturday from the Brownstown Presbyterian Church with the Rev. Edsel Granger, pastor, officiating, Burlal in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mr. Irwin was born April 21, 1884, at Hayden, the son of the late Abraham B. and Ella Priscilla Hubble Irwin. He was married in 1910 to Nonia B. Hays, of Brownstown, who survives. They spent the early years of their married life in southern Indiana but left this state in 1920. Many friends in this area mourn his death.
