## Warren Irwin

Warren Irwin, 83, of 823 S. Main St., Brownstown, died at 4:09 p.m. Friday at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital.

He was a World War I Navy veteran and was a member of Brownstown Presbyterian Church, Brownstown Masonic Lodge, Indianapolis Scottish Rite and Seymour Elks Club.

He was born Sept. 13, 1896, in Owen County to the late Dr. A.B. Irwin and Ella Hubbell and married Helen Hulse on Feb. 29, 1919, in Vernon. She survives.

They moved to Jackson County in 1955 where he owned Irwin Insurance Co. from 1955 to 1968.

Survivors include his wife, Helen, and two brothers, William H. Irwin, Bloomington, and C.O. Irwin, Fort Worth, Texas. Two brothers and two sisters preceded him in death.
