Allan Lee Lucas, 93, of 202 E. Bridge St., Brownstown, died at 3:44 a.m. Tuesday, Aug. 8, at the Jackson County Hospital.

A lifelong Jackson County resident, he was a member of the Brownstown United Methodist Church, Brownstown Lions Club, the Masons since 1920, and the Knights of Pythias for 71 years. He operated the Lucas Insurance Agency from 1914 until his retirement in 1976, and was manager-secretary of the Jackson Federal Savings and Loan Co. of Brownstown for many years.

He was born March 12, 1885, in Niles, Mich., to the late James and Laura Tip Long Lucas. On June 23, 1907, he married the former Orpha Lockman, who died in 1973.
