Anna Kadlecova Lucas, 86, of Brownstown, died at 2:24 a.m. Monday, May 25, 2009, at Schneck Medical Center, Seymour.

She was born Jan. 14, 1923, at Pilsen Czech Republic, a daughter of Joseph and Barbara (Kadlee) Kadlecova. On Aug. 22, 1945, at Pilsen, she married Edward R. Lucas, and he died Feb. 17, 1994.

She came to this country on July 4, 1946. In her younger years, she was a 4-H leader for 15 years. She was president of Willing Workers of Pleasant Grove. She was a member of Honeytown Extension Club, a member of the American Legion Auxiliary Brownstown, a member of Jackson County Historical Society and Jackson County Craft Club. She was well known for her cake decorating and was called "Cake

Lady." She was a faithful member of the Surprise United Methodist Church.
