Funeral Rites Held Here For Dort Lucas

Funeral rites were held from the Zabel Funeral Home Saturday afternoon for Dort Lucas, 40-year-old Brownstown resident, who died late Wednesday night at the Veterans' Hospital, Indianapolis, following an illness of two months.

A veteran of World War II, Mr. Lucas was born in Free-town on February 20, 1915, a son of the late John and Minnie Tatlock Lucas. He was married on September 3, 1946, at Connersville, to Violet Jean Lawson, who survives.

A truck driver by occupation, Mr. Lucas had been a resident of Brownstown for the past five years. He was a member of the Baptist Church in Greensburg, Kansas.

The Rev. Myron Hinton, pastor of the Brownstown Baptist Church, was in charge of the funeral rites, and burial was in Fairview Cemetery.
