George B. Lucas B'town R1, Dies

George B. Lucas, 78, Brownstown R1, died at his country home in the Pleasant Grove neighborhood at 11 o'clock Tuesday night. He had been seriously ill for the last two months, after having been in poor health for several years.

Mr. Lucas was born on September 22, 1877, the son of the late John W. and Suzzane E. Sanders Lucas, in Jackson county and resided here his entire life.

He was married in Jackson county on November 3, 1901, to Sinia B. Kern who preceded him in death in January, 1945.

Mr. Lucas was a member of the Pleasant Grove Methodist Church, and worked as a farmer until the time of his retirement. He was widely known and well liked in the community.

Surviving him are seven children: Mrs. Hazel Rudolph, Free-town; Mrs. Edna May Hancock, Mitchell, Ind.; Mrs. Gladys Gerkin, Brownstown; Clarence M. Lucas, Seymour; Roy W. Lucas, Columbus; Ray Lucas, Norman R1, and Edward Lucas, who lives at his father's home. Two daughters and one son preceded him in death. He is also survived by a half-brother, Henry Lucas, Brownstown, and by 18 grandchildren and eight great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon from the Pleasant Grove Methodist Church. No minister has as yet been selected since the regular minister of that church is ill. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
